

Visual Route Manager Version 1.35

- Changes that are made in the Visual Route Manager will now be recorded through the Change Log report in PestPac.
- You can now plot and show route/optimize for Setups. In order to route Setups, a date range needs to be entered on the Search screen. When rescheduling setups, you can change the work time, time range, and duration.
- The "Remember Me" option on the log in screen now respects "Allow users to remember password" on the Company Setup screen in PestPac
- "Commit Changes Permanently" has been added to the Edit menu option and there is now a Hotkey keyboard shortcut for it.
- You can now type the Technician code on the Route display screen.
- Square images designate Locked appointments. Locked appointments can only be selected if a Location has a mix of locked and un-locked orders displayed, otherwise locked orders can not be selected.
- You can now enter an arbitrary Starting and Ending address when showing a route.
- Added the Measurement field to Locations that are selected or hovered (or right clicked) on.
- The annual value has been added to Service Orders and Locations (this also now shows on the pop-up when you either right click or rest your mouse on a location).
- Added new Preferences screen under the File menu that will allow users to customize certain aspects of the VRM. Please note that these preferences are work station specific, not user specific. If you setup preferences on one computer and then log into the VRM from a different computer, your preferences will not be there.
 - Remember Search Options. If selected, the search criteria that was entered when the first search was done will be remembered of you select Search and want to do a second search.
 - Double Click opens item in PestPac. If selected you can double click on a location to open it up in PestPac.
 - Plot Locations by address or latitude/longitude. This option will allow users to force the order in which the VRM will attempt to plot a location. You can either plot by address first and latitude/longitude second, or plot by latitude/longitude first and address second.
 - Toggle Location Information. To see more information about a location, you can choose either hover or right click. Hover means you can just rest your mouse over the location and right click means you have to right click on the location to see more information.
- You can no longer edit the work time when "viewing" invoice information
- Added location sensor to map screen. As you move your mouse around the map, you will see the latitude and longitude numbers changing according to where your mouse is on the map.

- Added a dynamic scale reference to bottom of map. This scale will change as you change the size and closeness of the map.
- When “Committing Changes Permanently”, if the schedule code is to be changed, we update the Last Gen Date to the new work Date.
